
National Education System

ENROLMENT INTO HEIs

There are different entry requirements for enrolment into different higher education programmes.

1

- **Foundation / Matriculation / Certificate / Diploma** (Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia or any equivalent (10/11 years secondary education certificate)
- **Bachelor Degree** (Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia or equivalent (12/13 years secondary education certificate), Foundation, Matriculation, Diploma)

Generally there is no requirement for student to sit for any entrance exam for enrolment into higher education. However, for Malaysian students who wishes to enroll into public universities and institutions, they have to apply through **UPU Online**

MQA has published the list of entry qualification for international qualification. If the qualifications is not listed in the website. MQA offer the service of **equivalency evaluation for secondary and tertiary level** to help qualification holders determine which level of study they can apply for.



MODELS OF HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAMMES IN PRIVATE COLLEGES

PARTIAL PROGRAMME


- **Twinning programme** – the student partially completes the award at the private college and completes the remaining years at the partner institution, which then awards the qualification.
- **Credit transfer programme** – the private college has an agreement with a number of foreign institutions so students can transfer the credits from their studies towards a degree programme at their chosen overseas institution.
- **Advanced standing programme** – students study for one or two years at the private college. They can then get recognition for part of or all of their study to gain advanced standing to complete the remaining portion of the degree programme at a foreign institution.

FULL PROGRAMME

- **3+0 programme** – the entire programme is offered in Malaysia by a private college on behalf of the foreign partner institution.
- **External programmes** – the student registers for the external programme of a foreign university, and the private college acts as a tutorial centre. The degree gained is identical to the one awarded to the internal students of the foreign university.
- **Distance learning** – similar to the external programme, students learn through video conferencing and audio-visual materials with tutorial support provided by the private college.





- **To accredit courses that fulfill the set criteria and standards**

- To facilitate the recognition & articulations of qualifications

- To implement MQF as reference point for Malaysian qualifications

Act 679

MALAYSIAN QUALIFICATIONS AGENCY ACT 2007

An Act to establish the Malaysian Qualifications Agency as the national body to implement the Malaysian Qualifications Framework, to accredit higher educational programmes and qualifications, to supervise and regulate the quality and standard of higher education providers, to establish and maintain the Malaysian Qualifications Register and to provide for related matters.

Compliance with the Framework

37. (1) No programme or qualification shall be accredited unless it complies with the Framework.

(2) All higher education providers conducting an accredited programme or awarding an accredited qualification shall comply with the Framework.

Chapter 3

Foreign programmes and qualifications

Application for accreditation

56. (1) An application by a higher education provider for the accreditation of a foreign programme or qualification, foreign qualification offered by distance learning and joint and collaborative qualifications, other than a programme or qualification under Chapters 2 and 5, shall be made to the Agency within the specified period in the certificate of provisional accreditation in such form and manner as may be prescribed.

Private Higher Educational Institutions Act 1996 (Act 555)

- The Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) deals with the licensing and the establishment of transnational arrangements.
- All TNE programmes offered by foreign branch campuses or offered under franchise arrangement with local partners need to acquire and maintain MQA accreditation as a pre-requisite for MoHE's approval of programme offering as well as its renewal.





QUALITY ASSURANCE DOCUMENTS



Malaysian Qualifications Framework is an instrument that develops and classifies qualifications based on a set of criteria that are approved nationally and benchmarked against international best practices, and which clarifies the earned academic levels, learning outcomes of study areas and credit system based on student academic load.



Code of practice is a guideline for all the stakeholders about the seven quality assurance evaluation areas for quality assurance purposes.



The documents are part of a series of guidelines that are similarly designed to assist HEPs implement the practices and standards listed in COPPA and COPIA (the Codes of Practice).





Standards document sets general guideline of certain qualification levels based on the Malaysian Qualifications Framework (MQF).



Criteria set based on what is considered the minimum level that should be attained by the HEPs to ensure academic programme in a particular field of study can be adequately delivered. It covers all the MQF qualification levels; from certificate up to doctoral degree.

PROVISIONAL ACCREDITATION

Provisional Accreditation – is an exercise to determine whether a programme has met the minimum quality requirements preliminary to Full Accreditation.



FULL ACCREDITATION

Full Accreditation – an assessment exercise to ascertain that the teaching, learning and all other related activities of a programme provided by a higher education provider have met the quality standards and are in compliance with the MQF.

Monitoring of Accreditation Conditions (as per specified time period) and FA Compliance Audit Every 3-5 years

TYPES OF TNE IN MALAYSIA

Foreign Branch Campus - universities that have been invited by the Malaysian Government to establish their off-shore campus in Malaysia.

Franchise Programme - Programme offered and conducted by a HEP but the curriculum is owned, and the award is conferred, by its partner (the awarding body). The arrangement must be mutually agreed via MoA.

Programme under Certification Bodies (ACCA, CIMA, LCCI, ABE) – Programmes/qualifications from a certification body that is approved by the authorities in the country of origin. This qualifications must undergo equivalency assessment.

Joint Award – A collaborative programme developed by 2 (or more) equal standing HEPs that will lead to an academic qualification, in which the scroll will state the name of the HEPs involved.

Dual Degree - two programs of study from the same or almost the same fields involving cooperation by two-degree granting institutions of equal standing and leading to the awarding of two scrolls by the institutions involved.

Double Degree - Students will follow 2 academic programmes of the same level in different field of studies in the same institution or different institution, with greater volume of learning, and be awarded with 2 academic qualifications by the relevant institutions

**PENGUNAAN TEKNOLOGI KECERDASAN BUATAN GENERATIF
(GENERATIVE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE) DALAM PENDIDIKAN TINGGI**

PENDAHULUAN

1. Kepsatan kemajuan teknologi digital yang semakin canggih dengan pelbagai fungsi yang boleh diakses secara terbuka oleh orang awam menuntut warga pendidikan tinggi untuk mempertingkatkan pemahaman berkaitan pelbagai aspek konsep, potensi dan risiko teknologi ini dalam memastikan pengekalan keberkesanan kualiti dan integriti aktiviti pengajaran dan pembelajaran (PdP).
2. PPT merujuk kepada Universiti Awam (UA), Institusi Pendidikan Tinggi Swasta (IPTS), Politeknik dan Kolej Komuniti. PPT juga merangkumi Institusi Pendidikan Tinggi/ Latihan Awam lain yang programnya telah diakredit oleh MQA.

**PERKEMBANGAN TEKNOLOGI KECERDASAN BUATAN GENERATIF DALAM
PENGAJARAN DAN PEMBELAJARAN (PdP)**

3. Kecerdasan Buatan Generatif (AI Generatif) ialah satu bentuk kecerdasan buatan yang menggunakan model pembelajaran mesin (machine learning) untuk mencipta kandungan berdasarkan input pengguna. Aplikasi AI Generatif menggunakan algoritma untuk memanipulasi dan mensintesis data untuk mencipta pelbagai bentuk kandungan yang kelihatan baharu dan realistik seperti dihasilkan oleh manusia. Terdapat pelbagai bentuk aplikasi AI Generatif yang menjana kandungan dalam bentuk teks (seperti ChatGPT dan Jasper AI), imej (seperti Craiyon dan Midjourney), muzik (seperti Amper dan MuseNet), suara (seperti Speechify dan Murf) video (seperti Synthesia dan DeepBrain.AI) dan lain-lain. Kini, terdapat lebih banyak aplikasi sedang dan akan dibangunkan untuk kegunaan pelbagai pihak dan ini merupakan trend dalam industri teknologi yang sentiasa bergerak ke hadapan.
4. Secara umumnya, terdapat pelbagai aplikasi AI Generatif yang boleh digunakan dalam PdP untuk memperkaya dapatan maklumat dengan cepat dan mudah. AI Generatif boleh digunakan bagi menyokong PdP sekiranya digunakan secara betul dan efektif. Sebagai contoh, lanya boleh digunakan untuk:
 - 4.1 mendapatkan serta menjana hasil carian dari sumber Internet;
 - 4.2 menerangkan dan menganalisis hasil carian dari sumber Internet;
